

STANDING RULES OF ORDER

For Virtual Meetings

- 1. The Annual General Meeting will be conducted in accordance with *the Electronic Attendance at Credit Union Meetings Order* (Ministerial Order No. M138) and, to the extent not inconsistent therewith, the *Credit Union Incorporation Act,* the Rules of BlueShore Financial, and Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised.
- 2. Voting will be conducted by online polling or such other electronic means as may be determined by the Chair.
- 3. The Chair may postpone the vote on a motion to a time later in the meeting in order to allow voting to occur on multiple motions in sequence.
- 4. In a case where the votes of the members then present, including the vote of the Chair, are equal for and against a motion, the motion shall be declared negated by the Chair.
- 5. Members wishing to communicate with each other during the meeting shall do so by submitting a written question or comment via the messaging icon in the video conferencing platform. Such questions and comments shall be reviewed by the moderator and, unless out of order, shall be communicated to the other participants in the manner and at the time determined by the Chair.
- 6. Questions which relate to a pending motion must be submitted prior to the vote on the motion.
- 7. Guests and non-voting members may observe the meeting, but may not submit questions or vote and are not counted towards quorum.
